### NAMMO continues to extend their use of Dynaway BLUE.

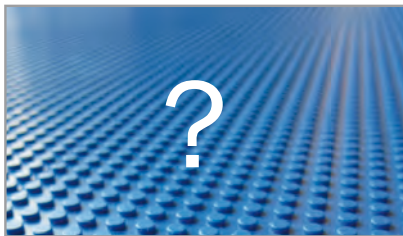
