# 1 Upcoming Changes

## 1.1 Dynaway Mobile Client Installation

This does not happen yet, but is a notice to inform you that it is coming.

The installation and update process for the Dynaway mobile clients will change.

We are striving to make it easier to manage the installation and upgrade process for the Dynaway mobile clients which will lead to updated installation guide, just one installation package no matter which mobile clients you are using, upgrading can be done with a simple script minizing the risk of faulty input. We are also removing the need to update the web.config file of applications, but rather use environment variables in the Web app - these will also be manageable through a script.

### Dynaway Planning Board

This does not happen yet, but is a notice to inform you that it is coming.

The name will change to Dynaway Scheduling Board.

The interface will be a little bit different, but you are still able to do all the tasks you do today. One or two features may have a different flow, but more on that when we are releasing it.

We are welcoming any requests to see prototypes of what the Scheduling Board will look like as well as a demonstration of the current status. Feedback on these will become part of the decision making in what to focus on and what to change.

**Known issues:**

- *If using the Edge browser on iPhone or iPad, and signing in to your AD account, closing down the browser will delete all cached data for the application and the user has to synchronize all data again.*
- *On some Android phones the event telling the browser that the virtual keyboard is closed does not fire resulting in save buttons sometimes overlapping close/cancel buttons.*

## 2 Summary

In this version, of particular note are:

- **Finance and Operations**
  - **Data manipulation toolbox**
    - You can now set up asset templates for validating asset hierarchy when moving asset to parent asset with specific combination of asset type, manufacturer, and model. It enables possibility to block creating new asset hierarchy which is not aligned with hierarchy defined in asset template.
  - **Maintenance compliance**
    - You can manage now control lots more easily by merging control lots into new one, moving assets from one control lot to another control lot, adding multiple assets to control lot or by setting up new batch job which validates regularly control lots and ensures that included assets still meet defined restrictions.
  - **Maintenance insights**
    - You can set up now floor plans which help you to track and manage in new mobile app the assets, rooms, and live data in a comprehensive and visually intuitive manner.
  - **Maintenance tasks**
    - You can set up and use maintenance tasks. They allow machine operators to perform their essential activities efficiently and effectively without the complexity of using work orders.
  - **Shutdown, turnarounds & outages**
    - You can define maintenance outage which helps you to coordinate and execute planned maintenance activities during scheduled power plant shutdowns to ensure equipment reliability, regulatory compliance, and operational efficiency.
- **Mobile Client**
  - **Work execution:**
    - **Better performance on data initialization and full synchronization:** We have greatly improved the performance for data initialization (previously entity initialization) and full synchronization of data to users in cases where data contains high numbers of fault combinations and job variants.
    - **Purchase order and purchase requisition:** More information related to purchase orders is now available on purchase requisitions to more easily see the status of those as well as purchase requisition information and link to them on the purchase orders shown in the work execution application.
    - **Complete work:** Let the technician complete work on a job or work order with a single click. The click will update work status, work order lifecycle state, add remark, set actual end on work order, register hours on job (if a timer is running).
  - **Planning board:**
    - **Standardized tab title:** We have updated the application title in the browser tabs for a unified naming convention across our web applications

- **Safe work:**
  - **New design:** Modernize the design of the application by providing a more elegant handling of the components
  - **PWA refreshing:** Add refreshing option of the application if a new version is available
  - **Loading screen:** Add an initial loading screen to make the entry in the application more enjoyable
  - **General Fixes and Improvements:** Stability and design coherence have been improved across the application.
  - *Note: This is not available for on-premise instance installations yet.*
- **Floor plan:**
  - **List:** Show list of floor plan available. The list can be seen as tabular or card view. List can be sorted and filtered.
  - **Create:** Add possibility to upload a pictures and create a floor plan
  - **Editing:** Add possibility to add or remove assets on the floor plan. The adding is done by locating a pin for asset at the top of the uploaded picture. Each pins can be then dragged in the desired position
  - **Details view:** Add a detail view that show a summary of the floor plan data (name, functional location, numbers of assets, work orders, and requests)
  - **Full view:** Add a page that show a full screen view of the floor plan. From this page is possible to view easily the related assets, work orders, and requests
  - **Deletion:** Add possibility to delete a create floor plan
  - *Note: This is not available for on-premise instance installations yet.*

-  **Installation notes**  
If you want to install Dynaway Floor Plan, it must be in the virtual path **floor-plan** same as the work execution application is in **work** and safe work is in **safe**.

## 4 Installation Notes

### 4.1 Feature Upgrading Form Type on Form Templates

After deployment of deployable package new feature "Dynaway - Form template form type" will be enabled by default in the workspace "Feature management" and it will update new field "Form type" on existing form templates from default form type "Form" to form type "None" (blank). If you install model files only and not deploy deployable package (e.g. in development environment), then you need to click button "Check for updates" in the workspace "Feature management" to get new feature added to feature list and enabled by default.

### 4.2 Feature Upgrading Project - Work Order Reference

After deployment of deployable package new feature "Dynaway - Project work order reference" will be enabled by default in the workspace "Feature management" and it will update references from projects to work orders. If you install model files only and not deploy deployable package (e.g. in development environment), then you need to click button "Check for updates" in the workspace "Feature management" to get new feature added to feature list and enabled by default.

### 4.3 Feature Upgrading Permit - Work Order References

After deployment of deployable package new feature "Dynaway - Permit work order references" will be enabled by default in the workspace "Feature management" and it will move automatically references between permits and work orders from old table "DynPermitAMFormWorkOrderRelation" (it has been marked as obsolete and should not be used anymore) to another table "DynFormInstanceReference". If you install model files only and not deploy deployable package (e.g. in development environment), then you need to click button "Check for updates" in the workspace "Feature management" to get new feature added to feature list and enabled by default.

### 4.4 Feature Upgrading Reference Type on Capacity Reservations

After deployment of deployable package new feature "Dynaway - Capacity reservations with reference type maintenance" will be enabled by default in the workspace "Feature management". It will check whether Microsoft feature "Work order billing" is enabled and if it is, then Dynaway feature will upgrade reference type from "Project activity" to "Maintenance" on all resource capacity reservations related to work orders. If you install model files only and not deploy deployable package (e.g. in development environment), then you need to click button "Check for updates" in the workspace "Feature management" to get new feature added to feature list and enabled by default.

### 4.5 Models Cleanup

We have cleaned up the number of models shipped. Models removed have either been merged or been deleted.
